Policy on Good-standing

1. Active participation is an expectation for all CiD members. Therefore, this policy is being created to define “Good-standing.” A failure to remain in Good-standing will result in a reduction of rank, which may continue until a member loses their membership.

2. To remain in Good-standing, a CiD member must do one of the following:
 - a. Post monthly in the CiD forum.
 - a.i. These posts may also be sharing videos, recipes, jokes, etc.

 - a.ii. Simply “liking” someone else’s post or comment is *not* considered a “post,” and will not be considered toward a member’s “Good-standing” status.

 - b. Join our current communications platform (TS, Discord, etc.) and game with us and/or chat with us for 30 minutes or more per month. This is a trackable stat.

NOTE: If a Senior Member is demoted for not following this policy, and then starts following this policy... that person will be promotable to Senior Member no less than 60 days after obtaining the status of Member and being active (as opposed to the existing new senior member policy of 6 months).

3. Any member may post an “MIA” post that will exempt them from monthly activity during the duration of their MIA.
 - a. MIA posts are good for 6 months at a time.

 - b. After 6 months, the player will be required to either return to regular activity or post another MIA for another 6 months.

 - c. There is no limit to the number of MIA posts a member may make.

- d. Any member who is in the military and is being deployed or otherwise needs to take an MIA for service-related purposes is permitted to have an indefinite MIA, and must note that reason when posting their MIA. Leadership is required to reach out to such players if their status becomes a question later. If a service member is inactive for two years, and unresponsive to messages from the CiD Leadership, they may be returned to active membership and reduced in rank following the normal protocol.

- e. If a member becomes inactive without posting an MIA due to an emergency, such as a health crisis, an accident, a death in the family, rapid deployment, or any other reasonable emergency, then the Officers group is permitted to give the member a retroactive MIA and return them to Good-standing and the rank they held at the time of the emergency.

- f. Any member currently "MIA" will not be allowed access to the Clan Member Voting section and therefore not allowed to vote in any clan member vote regarding any clan activities including but not restricted to: Recruit voting, Membership standing, Technology changes, Game server voting, etc. Once a member MIA status has been removed, they become automatically eligible to resume voting on any and all clan business.
